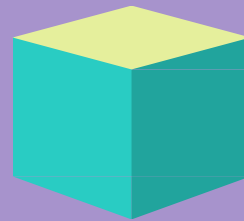


HOW TO PRINT

- Create or choose a 3D design within our guidelines.
- Decide which printer you want to use, and prep the file accordingly: MakerBot will require you to convert the file to a .MakerBot and Lulzbot will require you to save the project file on an SD card. Staff members can provide instructions for you.
- Once you have prepared a flash drive or SD card, staff members will sign you up and give you an estimate on when you can pick up your piece. Please pick up your prints promptly.

3D PRINTING POLICY

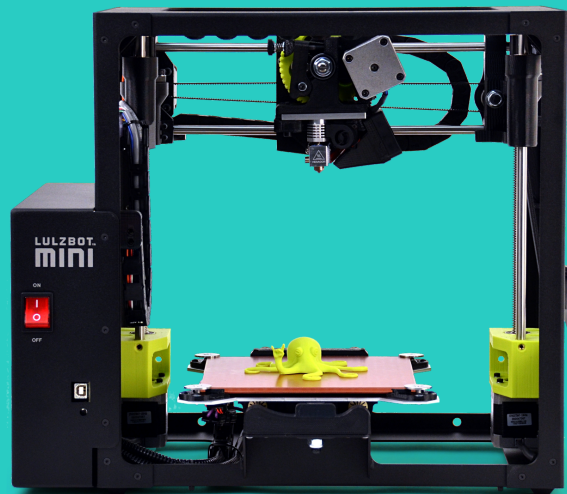
- The 3D Printers are free for library cardholders by appointment only.

OUR PRINTERS:

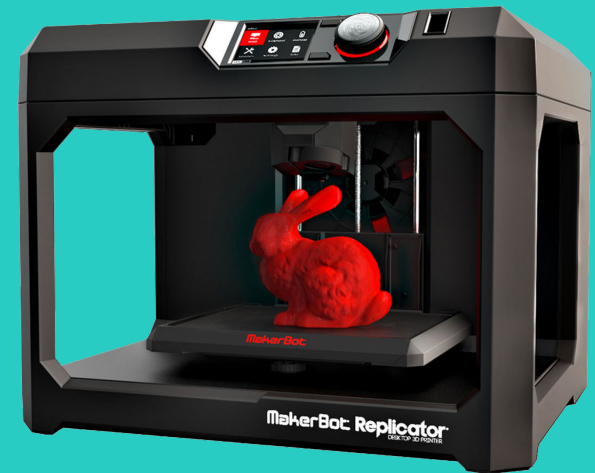
Lulzbot Mini 2

- Prints a 3D object from a saved file on an SD card.
- Small print area
- Heated build plate, so no curling.



MakerBot Replicator +

- Prints a converted 3D file from a flash drive
- Large print area
- Possible curling on large foundations
